Dear Board Members,

I have truly enjoyed and been honored to work for District #220 as a speech language pathologist. I feel very proud and fortunate to be a part of our District, and am excited about the direction and vision the school is taking for the future.

I am writing to inform you that I am pregnant and my due date is set for early May. If I were to deliver around this date, I would plan on using my sick days for the remainder of the school year (up to 14 sick days, 2 personal days). However, I feel it is important to inform you that this is a high risk pregnancy, with a high likelihood of preterm delivery. Both of my children were born at 34 weeks gestation, and with my second pregnancy I was placed on bedrest at 32 weeks gestation. In the event that I would deliver early/and or be put on bedrest I would like to use my 14 sick days and 2 personal days then finish out my maternity leave using days from the sick leave bank for the remainder of the school year. In the event that this would happen I would submit a letter from my doctor.
