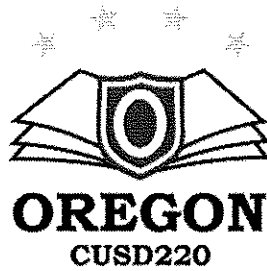
Name: Jamie Revelle

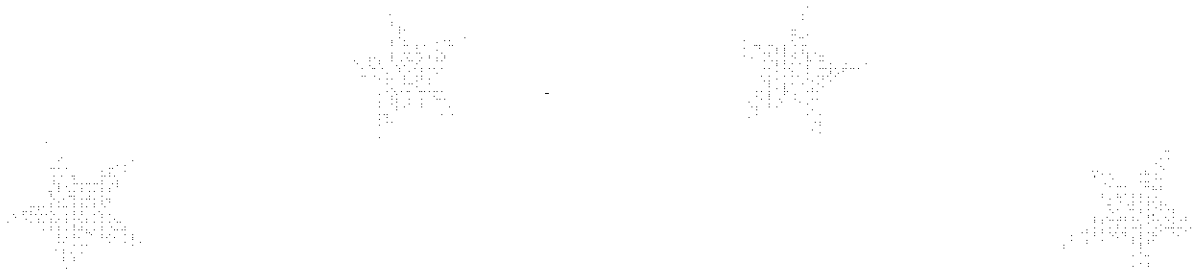
Mr. Mahoney:
