Dear Oregon School Board and Athletic Director:

I am submitting my Resignation as the Head Coaching position for the Bowling program. I would like to thank you for giving me the chance over the last six years to be the Head Coach of the bowling team. I am turning in my resignation for few reasons.

The first and most important reason, is that I am entering my last four years at my regular job and will have to work whatever overtime is available to help with my final four-year average. The amount of money that I will have to give up to continue coaching will severely hurt my average each year over the next four years.

The second reason, is I am having issues justifying to myself how I can continue coaching when I do not agree that specific other sports are given more paid coaches than other sports. I have had anywhere between 14 and 25 athletes ranging from Freshman through Seniors every year in the bowling program and have had to try and give them all the same amount of time and dedicated coaching. This is a program that has both boys and girls' teams and they are on two different ends of the bowling alley, especially on days of tournaments. It is virtually impossible for me to be at both ends of the bowling alley to watch the shots of each bowler and make the correct adjustments for them to succeed. It is extremely hard for a coach to concentrate on one team let alone trying to concentrate on two different teams at the same time on two different ends of a bowling alley.

I believe that the Oregon School Board should take a very long look at how certain sports are treated and given more paid coaches than other sports. I believe that the Oregon School Board should take a look at the number of athletes that have gone on to college on athletic scholarships in the sports that the High School offers. I think that you would find that Bowling is one of the highest, if not the highest in athletes going to college on scholarships. I know of approximately sixteen individuals that went on to college on some type of athletic scholarship in bowling. Oregon School Board and Athletic Director March 29, 2021 Page 2

In conclusion I would like to see the school board take serious action to hire a Head Coach for the boys as well as a Head Coach for the girls bowling teams. I know that there are several schools that pay both a boys Head Coach and a girls Head coach. I believe this is the only way that Oregon Bowling program can move forward and become even more successful than they currently are. I would once again like to say thank you for giving me the chance to be the Head Coach of the boys and girls bowling teams over the last six years. I would hope that the program continues to grow and succeed in the future, as well as become more successful than they are now.
