Winter Sport/Activity updates

Boys Basketball – As of Feb. 14, the Hawks have struggled to a 2-18 record. Oregon opened up the 2A Regional with a play-in game at Byron on February 19.

Girls Basketball – The Lady Hawks varsity team finished the season with an overall record of 8-23. They won their Regional play-in game at Port Byron Riverdale before falling to Winnebago in the Regional semifinal.

Wrestling – The Hawks finished their regular season with a fine dual meet record of 19-10 and went 6-3 in Big Northern matches. The team finished in 5th place of 11 teams at an extremely tough Dixon Regional. At the Sectional at Princeton, juniors Lane Halverson and Seth Stevens were able to qualify for the IHSA State Finals. Also this year, the IHSA conducted a girls wrestling post-season series for the first time. Oregon had Anna Marquardt and Elizabeth Ruter participate at the Naperville Sectional. Ruter took 4th place in her weight class and became the first female wrestler in OHS history to advance to a State Final.

Boys Bowling – OHS finished with a nice dual meet record of 16-3. At the Sterling Regional, the team finished 5th of 12. At the Hononegah Sectional, senior Isaac Kaltenbrun advanced to the State Finals individually where he ended up finishing 73rd overall.

Girls Bowling – The Lady Hawks finished their regular season with a record of 11-4 in dual matches. At the IHSA regional, Oregon finished in 4th place overall advancing as a team to the Sectional meet at DeKalb on Feb. 12. At Sectional, junior Ava Wight took 5th place individually and qualified for the IHSA State Finals on Feb 18 & 19.

Competitive Cheer – The OHS cheer team participated at the Belvidere Sectional on January 29 finishing in 14th place in the small school division.

Academic Bowl – OHS participated in the Big Northern Tournament on Feb. 15 at North Boone.
