Jump Rope for Heart is a tradition at OES. We have participated in the annual event for over 30 years.

In the past 12 years the Oregon and Mt. Morris communities have helped raise over \$111,216 for the American Heart Association. The program is run through the physical education classes so that <u>all</u> students have the opportunity to participate. It is an Event that the OES physical education department works collectively on. Jump Rope for Heart allows our older students to take on a leadership role and help the younger students learn to jump rope. We use the event to reinforce heart healthy habits in our curriculum. Last year we exceeded our goal and raised over \$14,000. OES was the top school in Ogle County and in the top 3 for our area which includes schools over twice our size. It is truly a community effort. Everyone from the students, parents, staff and our community have helped make it a successful community service for OES. Our goal this year is \$15,000. We truly appreciate you as a board and our Administrators for the continued support of the event.

The philosophy of the physical education department is that this is a community service that all of our students can participate in. The American Heart Association receives all of the donations given by our students. The AHA uses the donations for three purposes:

Research: Since 1949, they have funded more than \$3.9 billion in cardiovascular and stroke research, including work on clot-busting drugs.

Education: Emergency Cardiovascular Care programs has trained more than 10 million emergency medical services personnel, healthcare professionals and citizens in how to perform CPR or use an automated external defibrillator (AED) to save lives.

Advocacy: They work through legislative channels to increase funding for cardiovascular research and treatment, protecting the public from secondhand smoke and education.
