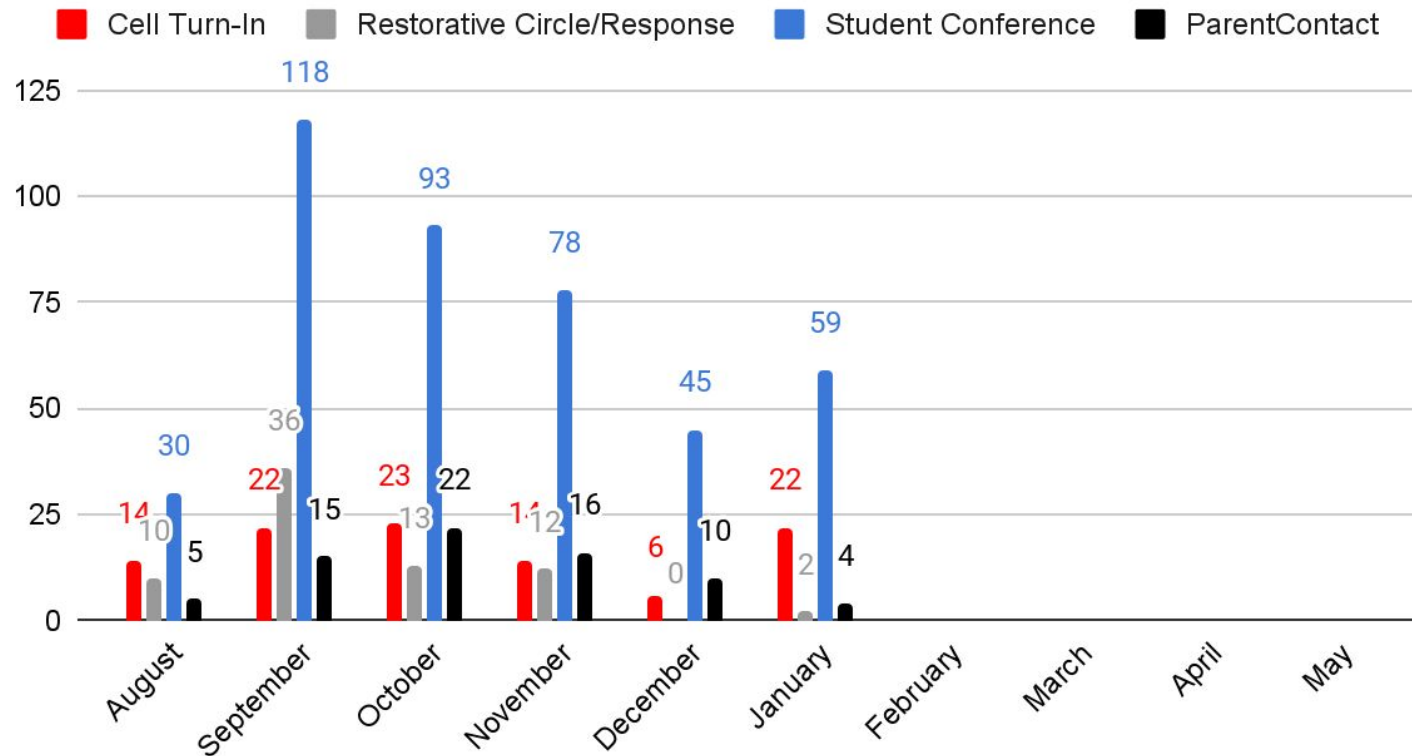

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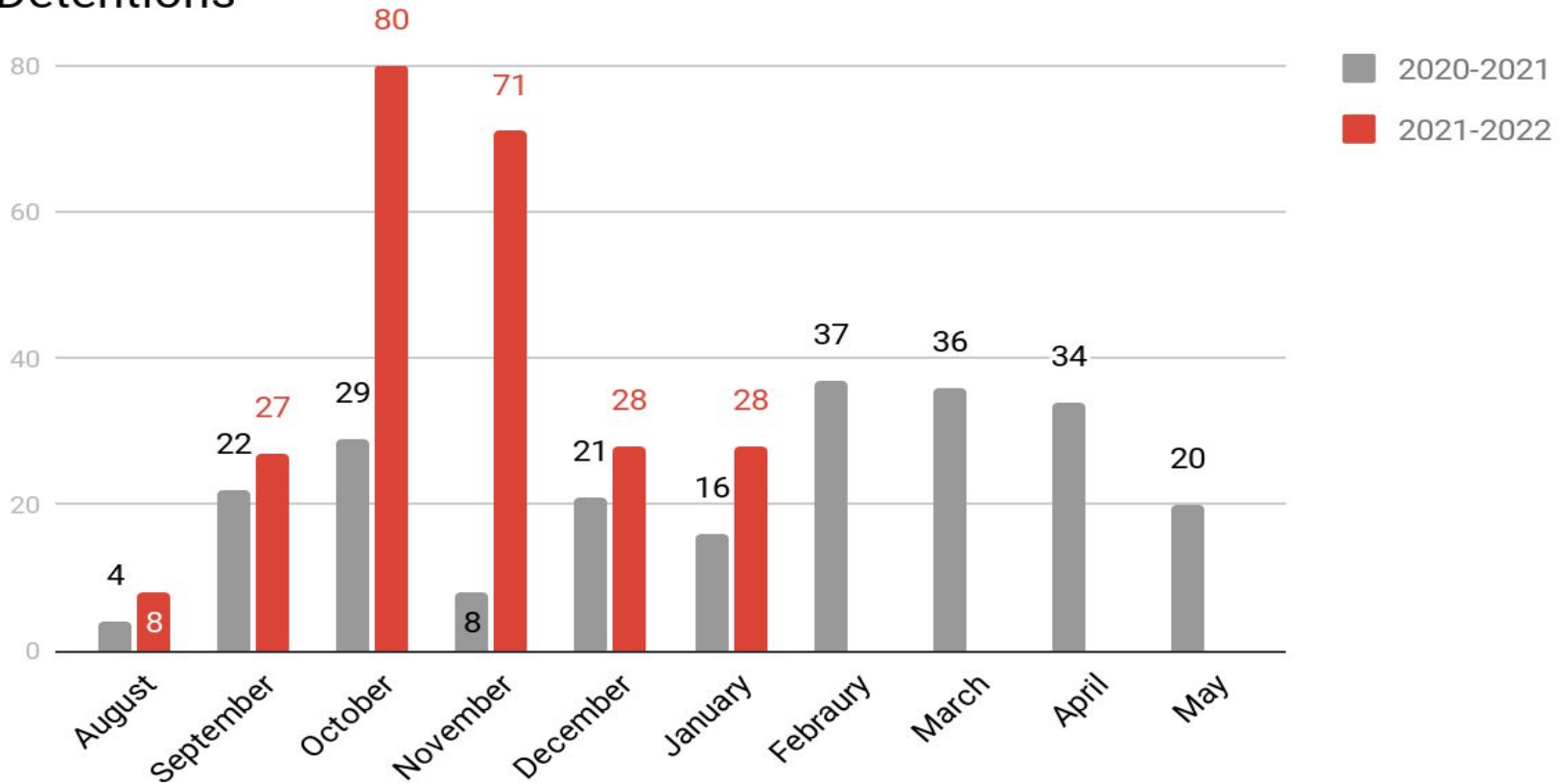

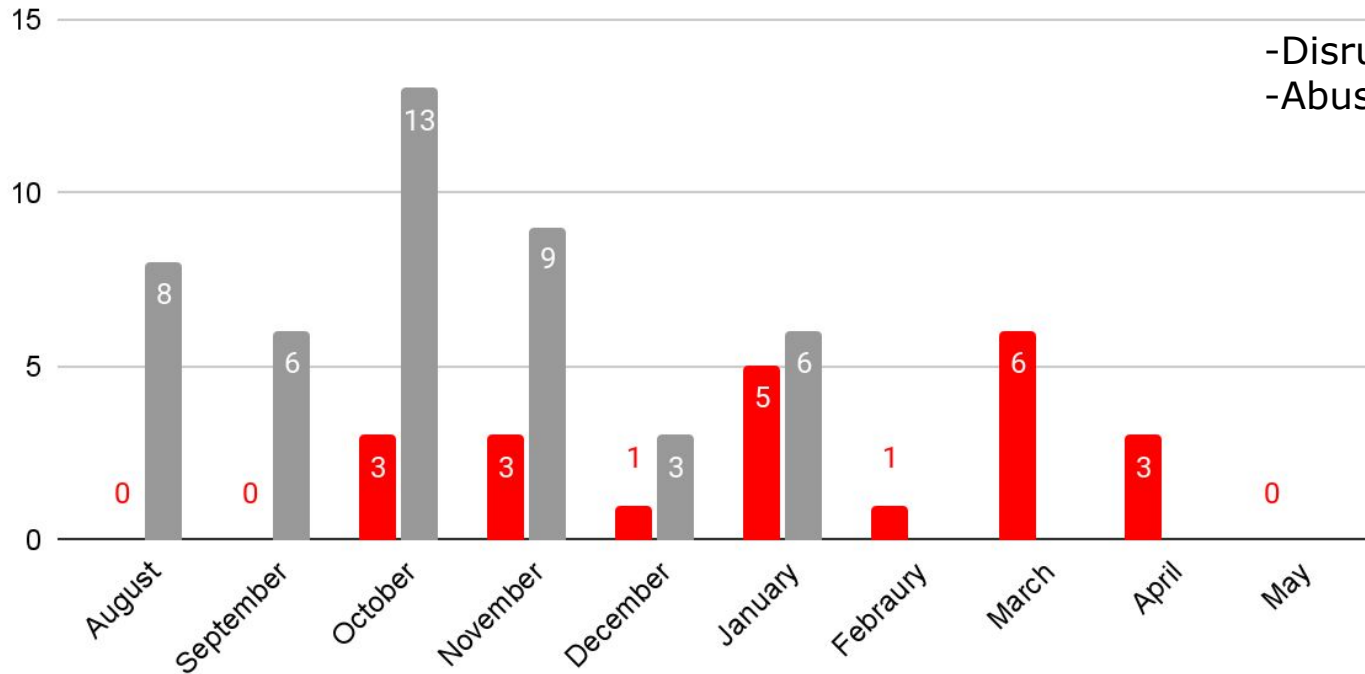




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In-School Intervention (ISS)

ISS Reasons:

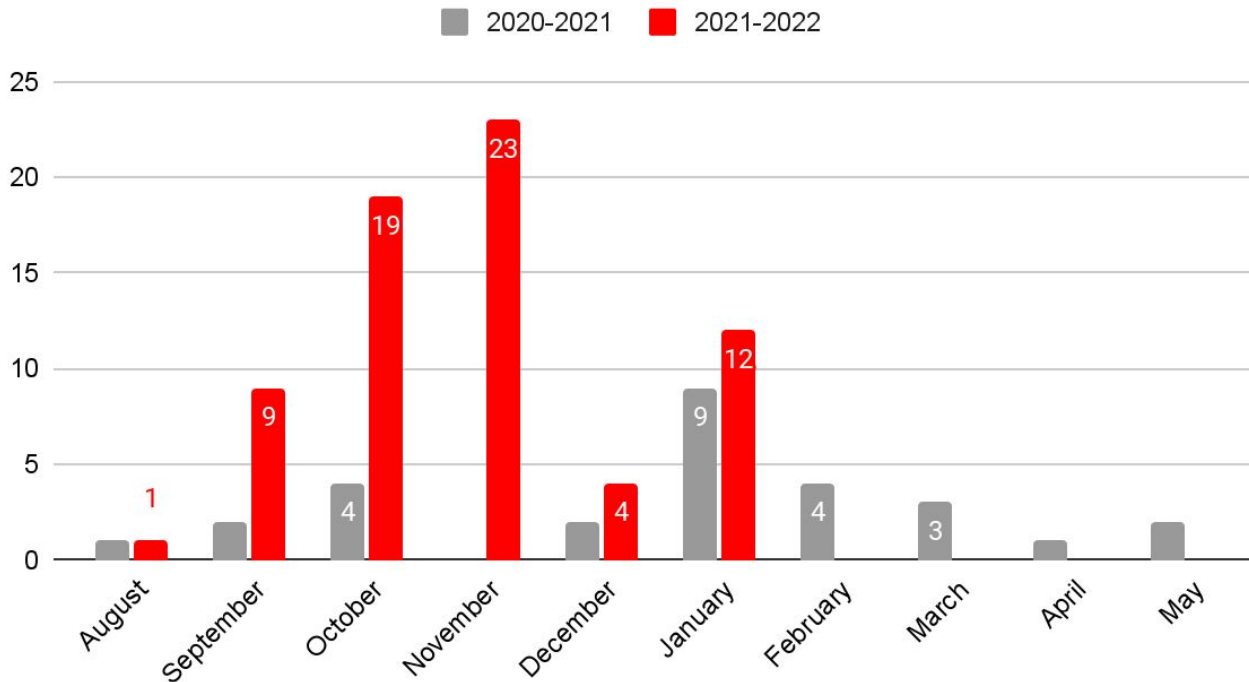
- Disruptive Non-Compliance
