School Improvement Goal 1 SAT score improvement

- Continued work on rigorous instructional methods
 - ICLE consultant visiting classes and providing teachers with one on one coaching
 - Instructional coach leading some on-line discussion and coaching via Google Classroom
 - Piloting of personalized learning in US History classroom using technology and individualized learning plans based on student need, integrating the rigor framework



School Improvement Goal 1 SAT score improvement

Three tier SAT prep from Jan-April

- Tier 1: In class prep integrated with content
- Tier 2: In class prep focused on specific skill deficit areas (ex: advanced math topics)
- Tier 3: Additional time (study halls/Saturday morning)



School Improvement Goal 2 Freshmen On-Track

- 96% to end the semester
- Plans in place to support the 4% who are off track, including some extended learning opportunities to get them back on track
- Working to adjust summer school to promote ontrack status as early as possible

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School improvement goal 3 Attendance

- 38 students with perfect attendance first semester
- Will continue recognizing perfect attendance
- Providing social emotional interventions for students who are struggling with attendance (social work/counseling to identify underlying issues)

 - 8th grade night January 28th










