## **December 2018 Monthly Report**

## **Oregon Elementary School**

- Mrs. Stewart conducted 51 individual student meetings with various students throughout the month for social emotional, behavioral, or academic concerns. Mrs. Stewart also facilitated 10 lunch time groups with grades K, 1, and 2. Several of these groups finished their 8 week sessions just before break and new groups will be starting in late January. Mrs. Stewart also held 3 Student Ambassadors meetings in December, this focused on the food drive which was very successful. OES beat their goal of 1,000 items by bringing in over 1,200 items which were all donated to Lifeline Food Pantry. Mrs. Stewart and the Student Ambassadors collected, sorted, counted, and boxed all of the items that were donated. Mrs. Stewart also delivered 26 classroom lessons to grades Pre-K thru 3rd grade. The sensory hallway is also complete in the Jefferson foyer, many students have taken advantage of this area so far!
- Mr. Montanola met with 48 students individually several times. He ran 27 philosophical discussion groups, 13 social skills groups and six peer conflict groups with a total of 117 students, and 158 individualized student work in class interventions. Furthermore, he taught 15 socio-emotional lessons.

#### David L. Rahn Junior High School

- Mrs. Cermak continues to meet with students individually and in small groups.
- Meetings this month included grade level meetings, Student
   Assistance Team meeting, student services department, IEP meetings at OES and
   DLR, and meetings with parents.
- Provided orientation to three new students and their parents.

### **Oregon High School**

- Counselors met with students who were projected to be off-track due to course failures. Counselors set up a plan with students and communicated to teachers/parents as needed to best support student success for the fall term.
- Counselors attended Problem Solving Team Meetings during the month of December.
- Counselors attended the Ogle County High School Counselor Meeting at Byron High School on December 18. Mr. Turffs worked with Byron to host the meeting and prepared the agenda for the day.
- Ms. Cremeens hosted two group counseling meetings.
- Counselors worked with students on second semester schedules.
