II. CODE OF CONDUCT A. DEFINITION OF OFFENSES: The following behavior shall constitute "offenses" which shall subject the offending student to the Consequences listed in Subsections II.D., II.E. and II.F. of this Code of Conduct and Drug Testing Program, whether the behavior occurs on or off school property, or during or outside of school hours:

- 1. Use or possession of drug paraphernalia, alcohol, marijuana, cocaine, inhalants, or other controlled substances.
- 2. Attendance at events where these substances are being used illegally.
- 3. Use or possession of nicotine products.
- 4. Commission of theft, vandalism, trespass, or other conduct that is a violation of the criminal code, with the exception of minor traffic offenses;
- 5. Participation in, encouragement of, or facilitation of hazing.
- 6. Participation in, encouragement of, or facilitation of flagrantly inappropriate behavior.
- 7. Behavior that constitutes gross disobedience or misconduct under the Board Policy addressing Student Discipline (7:190)
