Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct

Through December 10, there have been seven extra-curricular code violations at OHS since August 1. Three were for a off campus trespass incident before school started, one was for alcohol, and two for vaping at school. One was the RDT fail described above. All were first offenses.

Winter Sports Update

<u>Boys Basketball</u> – As of December 9, the varsity team has an undefeated 7-0 record. The Hawks won the championship of the annual Oregon Thanksgiving Tournament defeating Rockford Christian. Senior Trey Woolsey was named to the All-Tournament Team. The Oregon JV team is currently 3-5.

<u>Girls Basketball</u> – As of December 9, the varsity girls' team had a record of 3-4 overall. Sophompre Jenae Bothe was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Oregon Tipoff Classic. The JV squad was 4-2 as of Dec. 3.

<u>Wrestling</u> – As of December 9, the varsity wrestlers had a 2-3 dual meet record with an 0-2 record in conference matchups.

<u>Girls Bowling</u> – The girls' team has dual meet record of 3-0 as of Dec. 9. They took second place of 10 teams at their own Hawk Classic.

<u>Boys Bowling</u> – The boys are also off to a good start with a dual meet record of 9-1. They took 6^{th} of 12 at the Hawk Classic on Dec. 7.

<u>JH Boys Basketball</u> – Both the 7th and 8th grade teams finished their seasons at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament in Winnebago. The 7th grade team competed in the third place game on Tues. Dec. 10 and finished with a 4-3 record in conference games. The 8th graders went 2-5 in conference.
