November 2019 Monthly Report

Oregon Elementary School

- Mrs. Stewart had 55 individual student meetings this month. Mrs. Stewart also facilitated 7 lunch groups with students, the topics included: emotions, asking for help, and working together. The Student Ambassadors had 3 meetings in November, they worked on the Veteran's Day assembly and then began getting ready for our December food drive that is from December 2nd-18th. Mrs. Stewart also facilitated 40 classroom lessons in Pre-K through 3rd grade. We have been working through various emotions and coping skills. Mrs. Stewart attended the Student Assistance Team meetings for K-3 this month, as well as a CPI meeting, and several team meetings regarding individual students. Mrs. Stewart also was contacted by a local church who wanted to sponsor families for Thanksgiving so she spent time towards the end of the month contacting and coordinating with families to receive food baskets.
- Mr. Montanola met with 40 students individually several times. He ran 33 philosophical discussion groups, 37 SEL/social skills groups, one peer conflict group with a total of 102 students and 71 individualized student work in class interventions.
