2018 Summer School:

2018-2019 School Improvement Plan (SIP) Preview:

- Goal #1 DLR PARCC attainment scores for meeting and exceeding in Math and ELA will double from the 2017-18 results.
 - a. Use of rigor rubric during classroom visits (principal and teachers)
- Goal #2 90 % of DLR students will improve one attainment level from their 2017-18 PARCC results to their 2018-19 results.
- Goal #3 There will be an 80% positive increase in DLR student perceptions of themselves from fall of 2018 to spring of 2019.
 - a. Survey issued in fall and spring
 - b. Daily affirmations, building and classroom
