Winter Sport/Activity updates

Boys Basketball – As of Feb. 15, the Hawks have a 15-15 record. The JV team has a 17-13 mark while the F/S team is 9-19.

Girls Basketball – The Lady Hawks varsity team finished the season with an overall record of 7-24. They dropped their Regional opener at Erie-Prophetstown to close out the season. The JV team finished with a record of 13-13 overall.

Wrestling – The Hawks finished their regular season with a fine dual meet record of 16-11. The team finished in 3rd place of 11 teams at an extremely tough Stillman Regional and qualified six individuals for the Byron Sectional. At the Sectional, freshman Nelson Benesh and seniors Anthony Bauer and Quentin Berry were able to qualify for the IHSA State Finals in Champaign.

Boys Bowling – OHS finished with a nice dual meet record of 14-3. At the IHSA Regional, the boys had a tough day on the lanes and took 9th of 14 teams overall

Girls Bowling – There were only two girls out for bowling this year so they competed as individuals in several meets throughout the season. At the IHSA Sterling Regional, Oregon's Katy Miller finished in 38th place individually.

Competitive Cheer – The OHS cheer team participated at the Belvidere Sectional on January 28 finishing in 12th place in the small varsity division.

Academic Bowl – OHS participated in the Big Northern Tournament on Feb. 13 at Winnebago and finished in 5th place overall.

Jr. High Girls Basketball – The 7th & 8th grade teams will be competing at the annual Rt 72 Tournament in Byron on Saturday, March 2.

Jr. High Wrestling – The jr. high team will compete on Tues. Feb 20 at the Rt 72 Conference meet at Winnebago and then at the IESA Regional in Mt. Carroll on Saturday, Feb. 24.
