JANUARY 2024 BOARD REPORT

Oregon Elementary School

- In January, Mrs. Stewart focused classroom lessons on kindness and diversity. Students learned about Mae Jemison, Ruby Bridges, Rosa Parks, and Sonia Sotomayor. Mrs. Stewart also continues to meet with individual students for social emotional needs as well as skills needed to be successful in the classroom. She also continues to attend parent meetings, student teamings, BSAT and SAT meetings, and all other trainings. Mrs. Stewart along with a small committee of staff continue to plan the Mom's Breakfasts as well, the next one is on February 14th.
- Student Ambassadors helped to develop ideas for the spring school-wide service project. Mrs. Pace also came in and spoke with Student Ambassadors this month regarding the school lunch process and ideas students had regarding the current menus.
- Mr. Montanola met on a regular basis with 86 students including individual counseling, peer conflict resolution, philosophical discussion, and peer tutoring. He met a few times with 25 students for individual counseling and ran 19 philosophical discussions on how knowing differs from understanding. He facilitated 10 peer tutoring sessions and six



peer conflict resolution. Furthermore, he provided 65 individualized student classroom interventions, contacted six parents via phone call, and met with two. In addition, Mr. Montanola attended all mandated meetings.

Oregon Junior/Senior High School

Academic Updates:

- Counselors met with students for schedule change requests/finalizing semester two schedules.
- Counselors began one-on-one meetings with students to discuss course requests for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Dr. Deininger and Miss Cremeens met with Hawk Huddle periods about class options next school year. Mr. Turffs and Mrs. Cermak also met with classes to talk about the process for course registration.

Social-Emotional Wellness Updates:

- Ms. Peterson continues to check-in with students on a weekly or bi-weekly basis to focus on SEL and personal/academic goals.
- Ms. Peterson met with students in crisis situations, providing support for students.
- Ms. Peterson is preparing to start SEL groups in February with students.

College and Career Readiness Updates:

- Students met with counselors to discuss future plans in one-on-one meetings.
