# **Academics**

As we close the semester, our students experienced some positive academic gains.

# High School

Of note, two metrics that determine our rating as a school were very strong.

*Freshmen on Track* – we ended the semester with a 95% on track rate. This is important, as our freshmen on track rate from last year was only 84%. This is a target area for us at OJSHS.

*Graduation Rate* – we ended the semester projecting a 99% graduation rate. At this moment, we have one students off-track towards on-time graduation.

*Other data of note:* Students have show 10-15% growth on writing benchmark(ThinkCerca) and 15-20 points of growth on iXL diagnostics (math skill-building resource)

# Junior High

The junior high team spent a significant amount of time intervening with some of our most at-risk students the last month of the first semester. Their efforts led to great success for all students.

90% of our 7<sup>th</sup> grade students &

85% of our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students ended the semester passing ALL of their classes.

Our 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are also utilizing the writing and math skill-building tools. Their growth is also strong.

7<sup>th</sup> grade iXL (Math) 144 pts growth/ ELA 161 pts of growth 7<sup>th</sup> grade ThinkCerca (writing) 23% growth

8<sup>th</sup> grade iXL (Math) 37 pts growth /ELA 15 points 8<sup>th</sup> grade ThinkCerca (writing) 12% growth

# **Student Activities**

- The high school musical "The Addams Family" is cast and will be performed March 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. We are grateful for the time and effort being poured into this by the directors
- The junior high play, "12 Incompetent Jurors" is cast and will be performed March 17<sup>th</sup>-March 19<sup>th</sup>. As a reminder, this is student-led production. High School students choose the script, the cast and direct the play (there is a staff advisor, but they do not direct)
- Our Hawk Huddles are actively working on their service projects. Part of our SIP was to have every Hawk Huddle complete a service project this year.
