OHS School Improvement Goals

Goal 1: OHS students will improve the percentage of meets/exceeds by 3-5% from Spring 2019-Spring 2020 on the PSAT 9/10 and SAT.

- 98% of students on track (freshmen-senior) towards 4 year graduation
- SAT aligned common formative assessments
