School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals & Progress:

<u>SIP Goal 1:</u> DLR PARCC attainment scores for meeting and exceeding in Math and ELA will double from the 2016-17 results. Math and ELA teachers have been working with PARCC practice tests in preparation for testing which runs from Thursday, April 5th through Thursday, April 12th. We have shortened the number of testing days needed by utilizing two classroom sets of Chrome Books in addition to our computer labs.

<u>SIP Goal 2:</u> Focus on increasing student leadership roles in school such as leading school assemblies, planning SOAR activities and classroom responsibilities. Students were instrumental in organizing the "Safety first Oregon pride Act responsibly Respect everyone" (SOAR) reward day held on March 23rd. They conducted student activity sign ups, sorted selections and developed the different groups for the day.
