Current Enrollment:

7th Grade – 113 8th Grade – 94

SIP Goals & Progress:

SIP Goal 1: At each grade level 5% more students will achieve their MAP growth target*in the areas of reading and math and close the free/reduced vs. paid lunch status achievement gap in math and reading by 2.5%. *(as compared to trend data indicating what would normally be expected) Winter MAP testing is complete and RTi placement meetings will take place on Friday, February 5th. Further data mining will occur for use in our data team discussions the week of February 8th.

SIP Goal 2: 100% of DLR students will perform at least 10 hours of community service this year. Currently 69/207 students have eclipsed the 10 hour mark for this year, 33.33%. 24/69 students meeting are F/R lunch status, 34.7%. Second semester service projects need to be completed and we also have yet to complete our all-school service project. To date, 2,677 service hours have been completed this school year


SIP Goal 3: DLR will increase student connectedness by achieving 80% student participation in DLR sponsored extracurricular activities and 96% attendance. 2014-2015 statistics indicated 65% of DLR students did at least one extracurricular activity. It was discovered that 75% of paid lunch students had done at least one activity last year but only 54% of free/reduced lunch students. Updated with current known participants, we currently have 88% of our 8th graders involved in at least one activity (48% of which are free/reduced) and 72.6% of our 7th graders (of which 44.5% free/reduced.) Current student attendance rate is 95.95%
