| 15-20         | Updated school health and nurse information.           | The district has updated material related to health information in the handbook.   |
| 21-22         | Updated Return to Learn Protocol                       | The district nurse staff has updated the Return to Learn Protocol language, and the handbook was updated to match.   |
| 38            | Removed language regarding a tip line                  | The tip line is no longer active.  |
| 39            | Removed language regarding the purchase of string bags | String bags are no longer available for purchase from the OHS office.  |
| 39-40         | Updated current clubs and organizations                | The current listing of clubs and organizations required review.  |
| 53            | Removed language regarding class rank                  | After the graduating class of 2017, no classes will utilize the class ranking system.  |
| 53            | Added language regarding part-time student allowance   | Students are approved to be part-time students their senior year if approved by administration and parents so they can work.   |
| 54            | Updated graduation requirements                        | Graduation requirements were updated to include the incoming class of 2021.  |
| 56            | Removed language regarding class rank                  | After the graduating class of 2017, no classes will utilize the class ranking system.  |
| 57            | Updated honors course offerings                        | The current listing of honors courses at OHS required review.  |
| 57-58         | Update specific language regarding graduation honors   | The updated system for graduation honors and speaker was added for all future OHS graduates.   |
| 59            | Updated Premier Scholars language                      | The PSAE testing bullet was removed from the Premier Scholars language.  |
| 60            | Updated PE waiver policy                               | The policy language in the handbook and the course guide did not match.  |
| 66            | Updated the time considered "late arrivals"            | This time was adjusted to match our new schedule with an 8:00 start.   |
| 67            | Removed lunch detention language                       | Lunch detentions are no longer administered due to the new schedule. Students serve After School Time (shorter PM Detentions) instead.   |
| 76            | Update cell phone policy                               | The handbook committee decided to modify the consequence for cell phone violations. Previously, the consequence was an option of in-school suspension or phone turn in. ISS has been removed from the consequence, and students will be required to turn in their phone to the office. ISS will still be available in the case of insubordination related to cell-phone use. |
| 79            | Updated False Alarm policy                             | Edited possible days for short or long-term suspension, and added "possible" prior to recommendation for expulsion.  |

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| 81    | Police contact option added to bullying/harassment section                           | The option to contact police when warranted was not previously listed for bullying and harassment situations. That option should be available on an as-needed basis.   |
| 82-83 | Update dress code section as it relates to students wearing hats inside the building | Per the handbook committee recommendation, students may wear hats before 8:00, after 2:53, and during passing periods and lunch. Students should remove hats when entering a classroom. The policy will reflect a similar process to cell phone use.   |
| 82-83 | Update dress code section as it relates to students wearing razor back tops          | Per the handbook committee recommendation, razor back tops with appropriate coverage will be allowed.  |
| 82-83 | Update dress code section as it relates to students wearing high heels               | Per the handbook committee recommendations, students will be allowed to wear high heels.   |
| 84    | Updated intimidation policy  | Removed specific language on suspension and added options for flexibility based on the situation.  |
| 86    | Updated language to specify policy for skipping After School Times and Detentions    | The language did not specify the type of detention that was skipped and did not lay out the progression of skipping consequences with the addition of After School Time and AM/PM Detentions.  |
| 91    | Updated times for detentions, added no cell phones allowed during detention          | The times for detention required updating based on our new bell schedule. In addition, not allowing a cell phone during detention was added.   |
| 91-92 | Updated rules for ISS  | <p>Per the handbook committee recommendation, students may not possess cell phones during in-school suspension. They will be turned into the main office at the start of the day and picked up at the end of the day.</p> <p>Per the handbook committee recommendation, students who are assigned an in-school suspension will not be allowed to attend any other classes, including but not limited to Driver's Education and the Whiteside Area Career Center.</p> <p>Per the handbook committee recommendation, students will eat lunch in the designated area for in-school suspension.</p> <p>Insubordination during ISS was updated to reflect a 1-3 day OSS, not just 3 days.</p> |

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| 97  | Removed Alternative to Suspension language | The Focus House Alternative to Suspension is not available anymore.   |
| 103 | Added Oregon Police Department contact     | The Oregon Police Department will be contacted for all offenses related to chemical use, and this was not listed in the handbook. |
