This is again one of the busiest May schedules that Oregon has ever attempted. This is caused by the IHSA awarding us postseason events in both baseball and softball, including both the Regional and Sectional 2A softball tournaments at Park West.

## **Spring Sports Update**

Baseball – As of April 10, the varsity baseball team is currently 2-5, 0-5 in BNC play. We have played several shortened JV games and innings as well.

Softball – As of April 10, the varsity softball team is currently 2-2 overall, 1-2 in BNC play. Due to the poor weather, we have not yet played a complete JV game.

Boys Track – Senior Ian Hussung took second place in the 800m run at the Illinois Top Times Meet in Bloomington on March 23. This is considered the unofficial "Indoor State Meet"

Girls Track – The OHS girls finished 1<sup>st</sup> of five teams at the only outdoor meet we have been able to have so far this season.

Girls Soccer – As of April 10, the varsity team has a record of 4-3-1 overall, and 1-0 in BNC games.

Junior High Track – The first two DLR Jr. High meets of the season were postponed due to the poor weather.
