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Summer School:

- 65 1st through 6th grade students are signed up for summer school. It begins July 11th. Summer school is for students needing an extra boost for the next school year. All students are attending on a voluntary basis. Students will work on standards from the previous school year as well as standards for the upcoming school year.
- Students will work on skills in the areas of reading and math.
- Transportation is provided for students in bussing zones and snacks are provided for all students.
- Families were communicated before the end of the school year, during the month of June and the week prior to summer school starting.

Professional Work:

- There are four teachers from OES attending the PLC professional development training in Grand Rapids, MI during the week of July 18th. This is in coordination with teachers from the OJSHS.
- ThinkCERCA will be here on July 26th for a training for 4th-6th grade teachers in the morning and OJSHS teachers in the afternoon.
- The kindergarten team will be providing an additional screening for new families or those who do not attend area pre-k programs on July 26th.

Family Communication:

- An email will be sent the week before registration opens for families reminding them that during registration, they are e-signing the handbook as well as the OES Form of Agreement. Information regarding the creation process for the Form of Agreement, how it will be used, how to access it, and a link to it will also provided in the email.
- We will have a new kindergarten family orientation as well as a new family orientation the first week of August. We want to provide two different orientations to better fit our families' needs. This has been put on the website and Facebook.
- A July newsletter will go out to all families after the new family registration date. Important dates regarding the upcoming year and activities occurring before school starts will be provided. A back-to-school newsletter will be provided at the beginning of August. Our newsletters are sent via email and posted to our website under OES and school newsletter.
- Communication has occurred with the tech department on how to add OES calendar items on to the main page of the district's website in order for families to see the information quickly and easily.
