# School Improvement Goal 1 Academics (SAT score improvement)

- Areas of Strength
  - Increased use of common formative assessments leading to student growth in skills identified as areas of need
  - Student survey to measure academic press & teacher expectations indicated that students feel they are being challenged; teachers working on common expectations throughout the district
  - Practice SAT and PSAT 9/10 scores indicate growth from last year
  - New classes providing additional opportunities for students



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# School Improvement Goal 1 Academics (SAT score improvement)

- Areas for Future Growth
  - Improve upperclass (10-12) on-track rate through summer school/night school programming for credit recovery
  - More consistent and systematic interventions
    - Parent/Teacher conferences
    - Mandatory tutoring





#### School Improvement Goal 2 Culture & Climate

- Areas of Strength
  - Developed the Lead team for Leader in Me; had several meetings and determined some positive messaging for around the building
  - Expanded student recognition
  - Added club opportunities for students to increase student connectedness & involvement
  - Student survey to gauge student career interests for the purpose of providing work based learning opportunities



#### School Improvement Goal 2 Culture & Climate

- Areas for future growth
  - Continue to work on integration of the Post Secondary and Career Expectations (PaCE) framework
  - Continue to develop language and expectations for "proud Oregon Hawks"
  - Continue to increase (and measure) student attendance, participation and involvement at all extra-curricular activities



#### School improvement goal 3 Professional Practice & Growth

- Areas of Strength
  - Professional Learning Communities teachers set SMART goals for their teams, they meet regularly to discuss student data and needed intervention, they are using a common agenda for minutes, they are discussing instructional strategies.
  - Nine focus instructional strategies; building a common language
  - Weekly teacher survey about professional learning



#### School improvement goal 3 Professional Practice & Growth

- Areas for Future Growth
  - Training and practice of teacher classroom visits (training on Jan 15 with ICLE)
  - Need expanded growth in the areas of trauma informed care, ACES and equity
