Oregon Elementary School

- Mr. Montanola met with 41 for individual counseling. He ran 31 philosophical discussions, 24 SEL/ skillstreaming groups, and nine peer conflict groups. In addition, he provided 80 individualized student work classroom interventions with a total 108 students.
- Mrs. Stewart met with 35 students for individual meetings. She also facilitated 33 classroom lessons, topics included the word “no,” wanting your way, and identifying emotions in others. Mrs. Stewart also held five lunch groups for K-1 students and 3 Student Ambassador meetings. The Student Ambassadors also sponsored a food drive for the month of December which was once again successful. Mrs. Stewart also assisted several local organizations with identifying families in need for the holidays and helped get the items to the families once they arrived. Mrs. Stewart attended several parent meetings, the monthly staff meeting, the PBIS/BSAT meeting, and facilitated the Kindness Committee meetings.

- Mrs. Cermak continues to meet with students individually and in groups. Second semester groups will start at the end of January.
