Winter Sports Update

Boys Basketball – As of January 7, the varsity team had a record of 10-6, 0-1 in Big Northern Conference play. The JV team is currently 4-9, overall while the Fr/Soph team is 5-3.

Girls Basketball – As of Jan. 7 the Lady Hawks had a record of 11-8, 0-2 in Big Northern play. The JV team is currently 11-8, (1-1 in BNC) while the fresh-soph are 6-1.

Wrestling – As of January 7, the Hawks have a dual meet record of 8-13, 0-2 in Big Northern meets. Both of the Hawks' returning state medalists are out with injuries, one of which is season ending.

Boys Bowling – Through Jan. 7 the Hawks have a 14-2 record in dual matches. They took 2nd place at the L-P Cavalier Classic and 3rd place at the Dixon Tournament in December. They also finished in 3rd of 16 teams at the Belvidere Invitational on January 4.

Girls Bowling – As of Jan. 7, the girls have a dual meet record of 6-0. They won the L=P cavalier Classic on Dec. 14, finished 7th of 19 teams at the Harlem Invitational on December 27, and 8th of 16 at the Belvidere Tournament on January 4.

Junior High Wrestling & Girls Basketball – Both junior high programs began practice on Monday, January 6.
