- Ms. Cremeens attended a CCAP meeting with Mr. Boyer to provide updates and discuss supports for students who are involved with probation.
- Counselors participated in data team meetings to plan the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Day lessons.
- Ms. Cremeens met with students involved in Project LEAD's student committee to discuss PSA ideas for addressing teen substance use.
- Counselors and administrators worked on the master schedule for the 2016-2017 school year.
