#### COVID

- Oregon High School recently hosted both the boys and girls varsity and JV basketball tournaments. The 12 team girls Tipoff Classic was November 17-20 while the boys Thanksgiving Tournament from Nov. 22-27 also had 12 teams for each level.
- Hawk Classic Boys & Girls Bowling Invitational @ Plum Hollow was held on December 4.
- Covid permitting, the 24th Annual Oregon Freshman Boys Basketball Tournament will take place on Friday & Saturday, December 17 & 18. Only two of the 16 schools have had to drop as of Dec. 14.

### **Winter Sports Update**

<u>Boys Basketball</u> – As of December 14, the varsity team has a record of 2-4 while the JV team is 5-5.

<u>Girls Basketball</u> – As of December 14, the varsity girls' team had a record of 3-8 overall. Hadley Lutz and Mariah Drake were both named to the All-Tournament Team at the Oregon Tipoff Classic. The JV squad was 1-10 as of Dec. 14.

Wrestling – As of December 9, the varsity wrestlers had a 3-4 dual meet record.

<u>Girls Bowling</u> –The girls' team has dual meet record of 4-2 as of Dec. 14. They took fourth place of 10 teams at their own Hawk Classic.

Boys Bowling – The boys are also off to a good start with a dual meet record of 9-2. They took 5<sup>th</sup> of 12 at the Hawk Classic on Dec. 4.

<u>JH Boys Basketball</u> – Both the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams finished their seasons at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament at Ashton. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade team went 3-4 in conference games. The 8<sup>th</sup> graders went 6-1 in conference and in lost to Byron in the championship game.
