### **SIP Goals & Progress:**

<u>SIP Goal 1</u>: At each grade level 5% more students will achieve their MAP growth target\* in the areas of reading and math and close the free/reduced vs. paid lunch status achievement gap in math and reading by 2.5%. \*(as compared to trend data indicating what would normally be expected)

<u>SIP Goal 2</u>: At each grade level we will close the free/reduced vs. paid lunch status attainment gap by 2.5 %.

<u>SIP Goal 3</u>: As a result of a focused effort related to "soft skills" (organization, goal setting, acts of kindness, etc.) activity participation, I am an Eagle, Eagle Hours and attendance percentages will increase over 2015-16 percentages.
