School Improvement Plan Progress

- Goal 1 (Increased SAT scores) Oct PSAT scores +3.4% Math; ELA stayed the same
 - English Department had a data session to examine October practice SAT scores for the purposes of adjusting instructional practice and planning for SAT prep
- **Goal 2** (Freshmen on-track) Currently 94.4%(increase)
 - Freshmen team has been vigorously implementing interventions to assist students with skill deficit areas and make up missing work
- Goal 3 (Attendance) 94.77 (increased)
 - Continued focus on perfect attendance on a monthly basis




Detention Count


Saturday School vs. ISS Count
