Oregon Elementary School

- Mr. Montanola met with 52 students individually several times and 116 individualized student work in the classroom. Furthermore, he ran 23 philosophical discussion groups, 10 skillstreaming groups and seven peer conflict groups. In addition, he taught 22 socioemotional lessons.
- Mrs. Stewart held 60 individual student meetings for social emotional concerns, academic concerns, and peer related issues. Mrs. Stewart also facilitated 15 lunch groups that focused on various social-emotional topics, 4 Student Ambassador meetings which focused on the Veteran's Day Assembly and the food drive, and completed 29 classroom lessons in grades pre-k-3rd grade. Mrs. Stewart also hosted the k-3rd grade students to a movie afternoon with the movie Inside Out since all grade levels completed their unit on emotions. Mrs. Stewart also made numerous parent contacts regarding holiday wish lists for several OES families who are being sponsored this year. Mrs. Stewart also attended grade level Student Assistance Team meetings, two individual student team meetings, the student services meeting, BSAT meeting, and the monthly staff meeting.
