Events recently hosted

- Oregon High School recently hosted both the boys and girls varsity and fresh/soph basketball tournaments. The 12 team girls Tipoff Classic was November 14-17 while the boys Thanksgiving Tournament on Nov. 19-24 also had 12 teams for each level.

- 22nd Annual Oregon Freshman Boys Basketball Tournament took place on Friday & Saturday, December 14/15 with sixteen teams.

Winter Sports Update

Boys Basketball – As of December 10, the varsity team has a 4-3 record, 1-0 in the BNC. The Hawks took 4th place at the Oregon Thanksgiving Tournament. Junior Trey Woolsey was named to the All-Tournament Team. The Oregon Soph/JV team is currently 4-6.

<u>Girls Basketball</u> – As of December 10, the varsity girls' team had a record of 4-6, 0-2 in BNC games. Junior Olivia Lambrigtsen was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Oregon Tipoff Classic. The JV/Soph squad is currently 3-6 while the freshman are 4-4.

<u>Wrestling</u> – As of December 10, the varsity wrestlers had a 3-5 dual meet record with an 0-2 record in conference matchups. The team participated in the Stillman Valley Invitational on Dec. 15 and will participate in Abe's Rumble in Springfield over Christmas break.

<u>Girls Bowling</u> –The girls' team has dual meet record of 4-2 as of Dec 10. They took fourth place of 8 at their own Hawk Classic and 2nd place at the LaSalle-Peru Cavalier Classic.

<u>Boys Bowling</u> – The boys are also off to a perfect start with a dual meet record of 10-0. They were champions of the 10 team Hawk Classic on Dec 1 and finished in 2nd place at the L-P Cavalier Classic on December 8. Senior Austin Strite bowled a perfect 300 game at South Beloit on Dec. 5.

<u>JH Boys Basketball</u> – Both the 7th and 8th grade teams finished their seasons at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament in Polo. The 7th grade team went 2-5 in regular season conference games while the 8th graders went 1-6.

<u>JH Academic Bowl</u> – The 8th graders finished in 5th place and the 7th graders finished in 3rd place at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament in Byron on Dec. 8.
