- IHSA Class 1A Boys & Girls Cross Country Sectional To be held at Park West on Sat. Oct 29.

Oregon will also be hosting an eight team junior high boys basketball tournament on Fri. & Sat November 11 & 12.

Fall Sports

Volleyball – As of October 12, the varsity volleyball team has a record of 11-10. They are 4-3 in Big Northern Conference play. They have earned the #2 seed for the upcoming 2A Regional at Dakota High School in late October. the Blackhawk Center. The sophomores are 10-13-1 overall, and also 4-3 in conference games.

Boys Golf – The varsity boys finished 8-7 in dual meets. They finished in 7th place of 11 teams at the BNC meet at Timber Pointe on September 29. At the IHSA Class 1A Regional here at Silver Ridge, Matt Myers, and Adam Merrill advanced as individuals to the Sectional. The season ended at the sectional as none of them were able to qualify for state.

Girls Golf – The girls finished with a 7-3 dual meet record, 5-2 in conference matches. At the Big Northern Meet on Sept. 28, the girls finished in third place. At the IHSA 1A regional on Oct. 5, the team finished in second place advancing to sectional. At Sectional, Abi Scheidecker qualified for the state meet in Decatur.

Soccer – The Hawks finished the regular season with an 11-10 overall record, 4-5 in Big Northern games. The Hawks hosted the 1A Regional Oct 11-14 at Park West, defeating Kirkland Hiawatha 6-2 in game one and moving to the regional final.

Football – Through Week 7, the varsity football team had a 1-6 record. The sophomores are 4-2. Due to low numbers by both OHS and some of our opponents at this level, all freshman football games have been cancelled.

Cross Country – OHS will be hosting the IHSA Class 1A Sectional Meet at Park West on Saturday, October 31. Before that, the team participated at the Big Northern Conference Meet at Genoa Kingston and will be at the IHSA Regional at Rock Falls on October 22.

JH Volleyball – The DLR 8th grade volleyball team finished in 2nd place at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament at the Blackhawk Center on October 1. The 7th graders finished in 6th place at the event.
