### **Fall Sports Update**

Volleyball – As of October 12, the varsity volleyball team has a record of 11-11 and is 3-4 in BNC game. place currently. They have earned the #5 seed of the 11 teams in the sub-sectional and will playing in the Mendota 2A Regional on Tuesday, October 26 vas Byron. The JV team is 16-7-1 overall while the fresh/soph are 6-13-1 overall.

Boys Golf – The varsity boys finished 8<sup>th</sup> place of 10 teams at the BNC Tournament at Timber Pointe on September 22. At the IHSA Class 1A Regional, the team finished 11<sup>th</sup> of 12.

Girls Golf – The girls finished with an 11-1 dual meet record, 7-1 in conference matches. At the Big Northern Tournament on September 23, the girls finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place of nine teams. Ava Hackman 7th (92) & Cassie Nyderek 11th (96) earned medals. At the IHSA 1A regional at Galena, the team finished in fourth out of twelve teams with Ava Hackman qualifying for sectional. At the Sectional, Ava shot a 79 to advance to the IHSA State Girls Golf Finals. At State, Ava finished in 42<sup>nd</sup> overall with a two day score of 89-79 for a 168.

Soccer – The Hawks finished the regular season with an 8-13-2 overall record. The Hawks lost their Regional opener at Stillman Valley 4-3 on October 9.

Football – Through Week 7, the varsity football team had a 1-6 records. Sophs were 1-3 while freshman were 3-2.

Cross Country – The girls finished 19<sup>th</sup> of 23 teams at the Amboy Columbus Day meet. Both boys and girls will participate at the Big Northern Conference meet in Byron on Saturday, October 16..

JH Volleyball – The DLR 7<sup>th</sup> grade volleyball team finished in 4<sup>th</sup> place at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament at the Blackhawk Center on September 29. They were, however, regular season champions. The DLR 8<sup>th</sup> grade volleyball team finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place at the tourney.
