August 2021 Monthly Report

Oregon Elementary School

- Mrs. Stewart attended the New Student Orientation
- Mrs. Stewart met with 20 students for individual counseling, facilitated 19 classroom lessons on the topic of germs/safety, and personal space
- Mrs. Stewart attended the CPI refresher training, BSAT meeting, student specific BSAT meeting, district meetings, and 3 parent meetings
- Mrs. Stewart assisted with our preschool and kindergarten teams during the first two weeks of school during transitions and lunch

- Mr. Montanola met with 45 students for individual counseling. He ran 14 social groups and 12 making thinking visible sessions. He also taught 12 SEL lessons. He has met on a regular basis with 85 students including groups. In addition, he provided 90 individualized student work classroom interventions, and met with six parents.

David L. Rahn Junior High School

- Mrs. Cermak planned/assisted with several events on August 12 including: New Family Orientation, IEP student Meet & Greet, and Meet the Teacher Night.
- Completed registration/enrollment activities prior to the start of the school year.
- Received initial certification in CPI (Crisis Prevention Intervention) through OCEC.
- Held annual review meetings for students with 504 plans.
- Met with every 7th grader for a brief individual check-in and began individual meetings with 8th graders.

Oregon High School

- Counselors completed registration/enrollment activities throughout the month of August.
- OHS hosted a New Student Orientation for all new OHS families on Thursday, August 12th.
- OHS welcomed new 9th grade students and families to Freshman Orientation on Thursday, August 12th.
- A new program was started through the counseling department called the “Hawk Ambassadors.” These students were nominated by teachers to help give tours and welcome new students into the district in August and throughout the school year as new families move into the community.
- Mr. Turffs began holding senior meetings at the end of August. Each senior has an individual meeting with their school counselor to talk about their progress to graduation and post-secondary plans.
- The OHS Counseling Department will start holding weekly meetings to plan programming and events for students and families this school year. The first meeting was held on August 26th.

- Ms. Peterson attended Leader In Me training on August 4-5th.
- Ms. Peterson attended new student/freshman orientation at OHS on August 12th.
- @ DLR Ms. Peterson had 27 individual student contacts
- @ DLR Ms. Peterson started daily morning check-ins with students- focusing on improving attendance. Students set attendance goals and choose a reward to earn if they meet their attendance goals.
- @ OHS Ms. Peterson had 16 individual student contacts.
- @ OHS Ms. Peterson attended three 504 Accommodations meetings with Ms. Cremeens.
- @ OHS Ms. Peterson started daily check-in/check-outs with students.
