The pricing quoted is based on May 2024 Federal Milk Marketing Order for Class I Skim and Class I Butterfat. This pricing is subject to change as the cost of raw milk changes each month according to the USDA Federal Milk Market Price Announcements.

The cost of milk fluctuates up and down each month based on the cost changes in raw milk.

Prices will also be adjusted based on cost changes in packaging, ingredients, labor, fuel, juice concentrate, re-sale products.

All price changes will become effective on the 1st day of the month following the price announcement.

Instructions for Certification

- 1. By signing and submitting this Certification, the prospective lower tier participant is providing the certifications set out herein.
