7th Grade – 107 8th Grade – 129

SIP Goals & Progress:

<u>Math/Science PLC</u> – The team has identified through fall formative assessment data those math concepts that are most in need of addressing. Probability and statistics for 7th grade and geometry for 8th grade were the concepts identified as needing the most attention. With geometry being hard to support in the science setting, probability and statistics was the second most critical area identified for 8th grade. Attention will focus on these two areas over the next few weeks through activities involving interpreting data and graphs and working with mean, median and mode. The next data sets the team will review are the winter MAP scores.

<u>SS/ELA PLC</u> – Nothing new with reference to this team. Winter MAP language usage scores will be reviewed in January as a benchmark for this work.

<u>SEL PLC</u> – Data is grim with reference to a comparison of Eagle Hours (community service) from last year to this. Last year DLR earned 2025 and this year just 202. Current circumstances will not deter the team from trying to increase earned hours from last year. Plans moving forward include and increased awareness of the importance of service learning through student council through the production of a video to be shown during homerooms, service forms being printed off and given to students with a a reminder to fill them out when service is completed and a Google Doc developed for staff to document service opportunities.
