<u>Math/Science PLC</u> – Review of winter MAP scores show an increase of students, over fall data, scheduled to meet expected fall to spring growth.

<u>SS/ELA PLC</u> – Initial review of reading MAP data, like math, demonstrates an increase of students who should meet spring growth goals.

<u>SEL PLC</u> – DLR conducted its first staff social on Monday, February 8<sup>th</sup>.
