Academics

- 9, 10, 11 grade students took a practice PSAT/SAT on November 4th. The results are as follows:
 9th grade: ELA 50 students (43%) met the benchmark; Math 30 (26%) met the BM 10th grade: ELA 65 (68%) met the benchmark; Math 38 (40%) met the BM 11th grade: ELA 55 (57%) met the benchmark; Math 7 (8%) met the BM
- Parent teacher conferences were October 28 and November 4th from 4:00-8:00 PM
 - o 92 Parent teacher conferences (22% of our students)
 - Meetings were held to address academic achievements and concerns to this point, as well as behavioral concerns and senior progress towards graduation

Student Happenings

- The fall play "Bad Auditions by Bad Actors" took place November 5-7. As a reminder, the fall play is entirely lead by students. Student directors select the script, cast the play, work on the set, lights, etc. The play was a big success this year.

All OHS students will be watching "Saving Private Ryan" and discussing the sacrifice our armed forces have given for our country. In addition, student council will be placing flags on the front lawn in recognition of the day and have also written letters to veterans identified by the local VFW. The choir is also planning a little concert that we will post virtually to honor our veterans.
