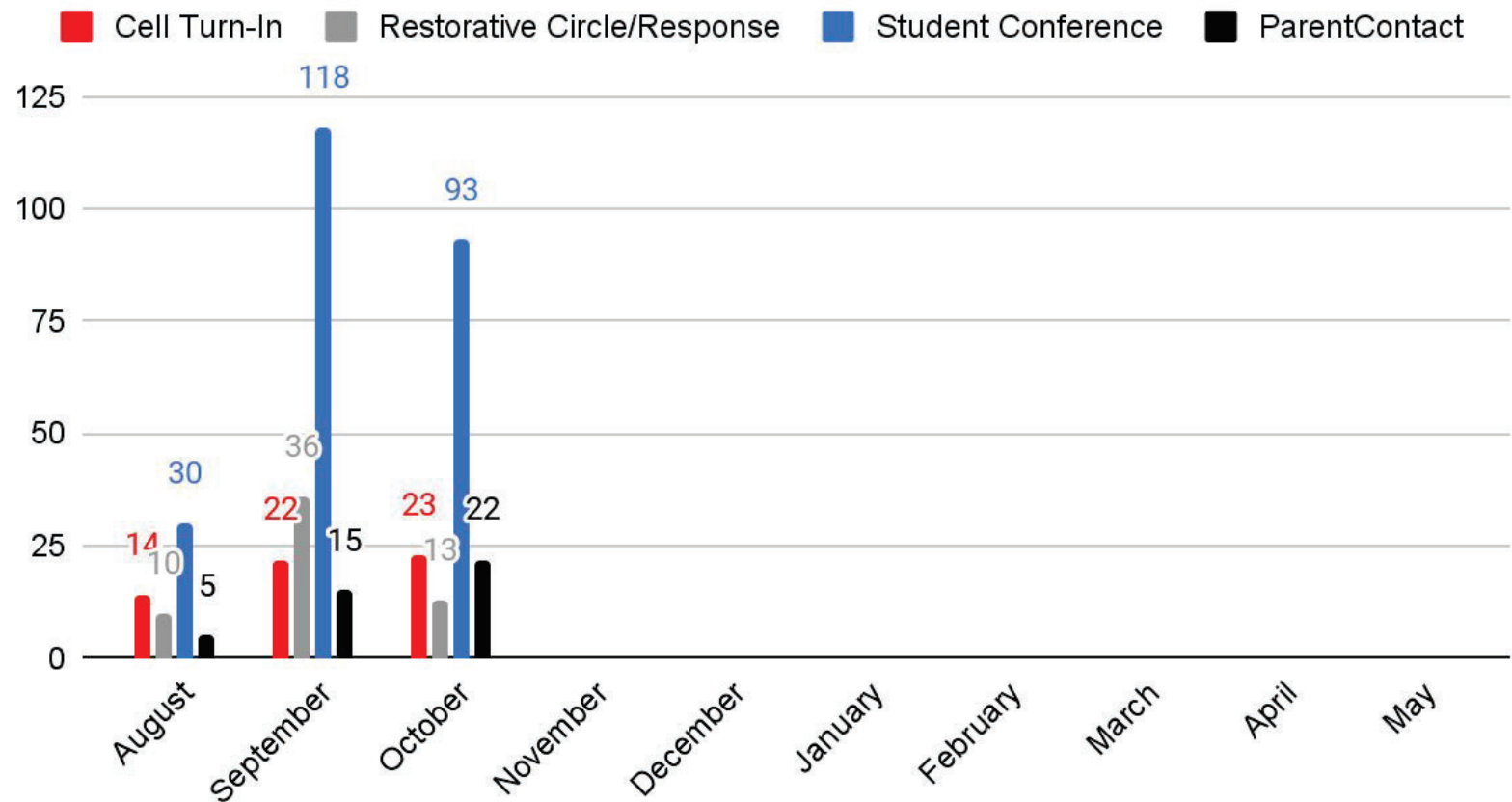

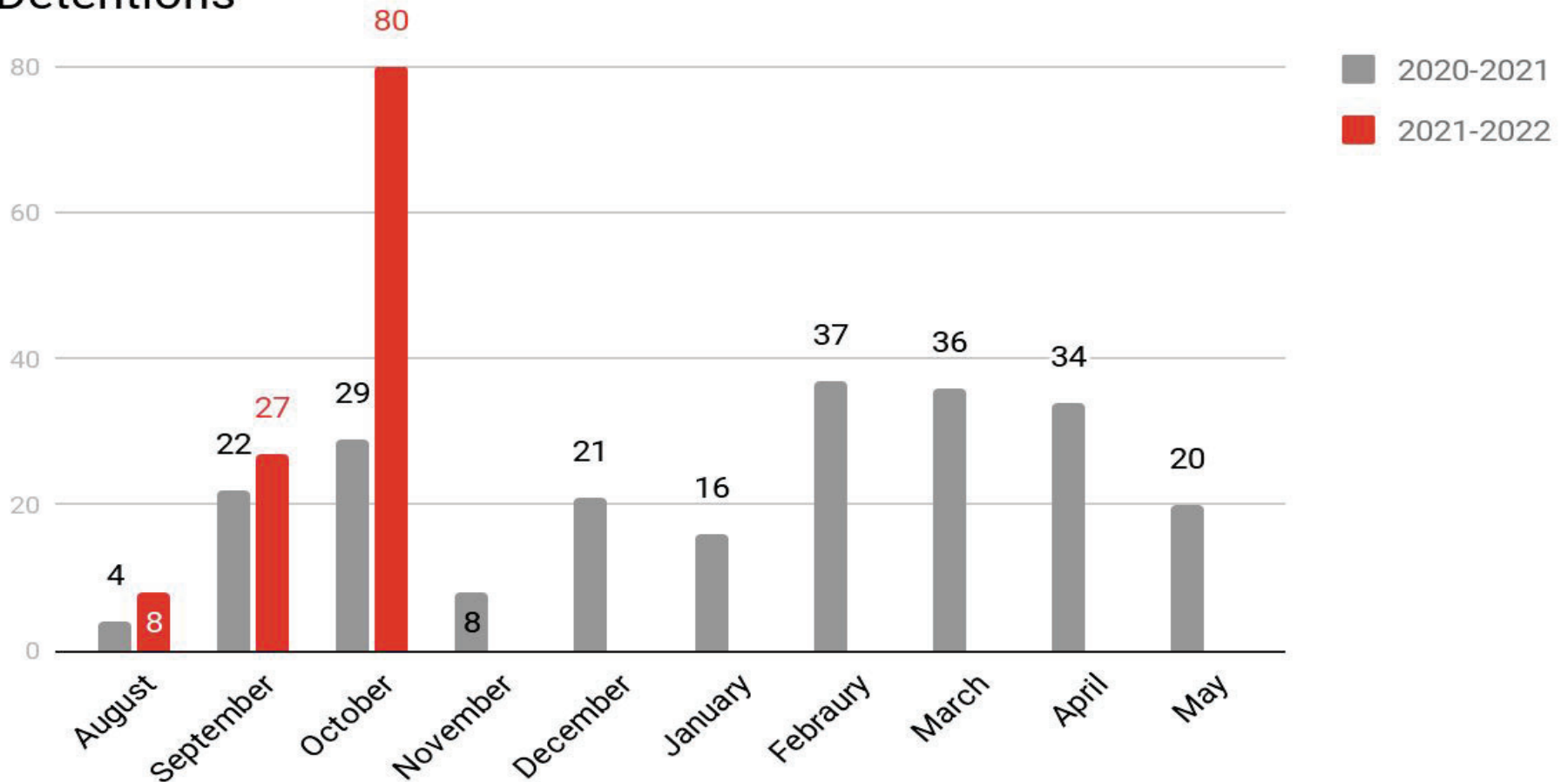

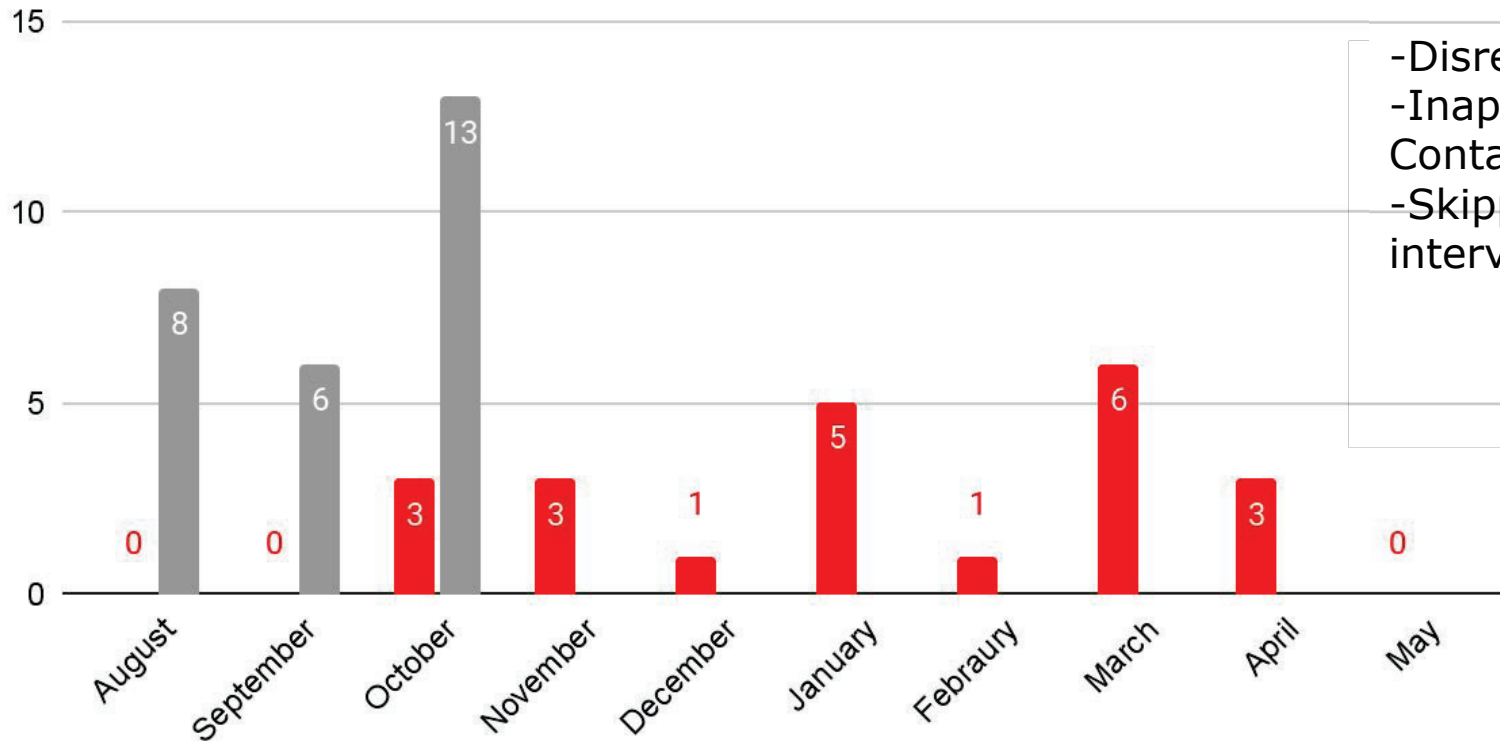

■ 2020-2021 ■ 2021-2022



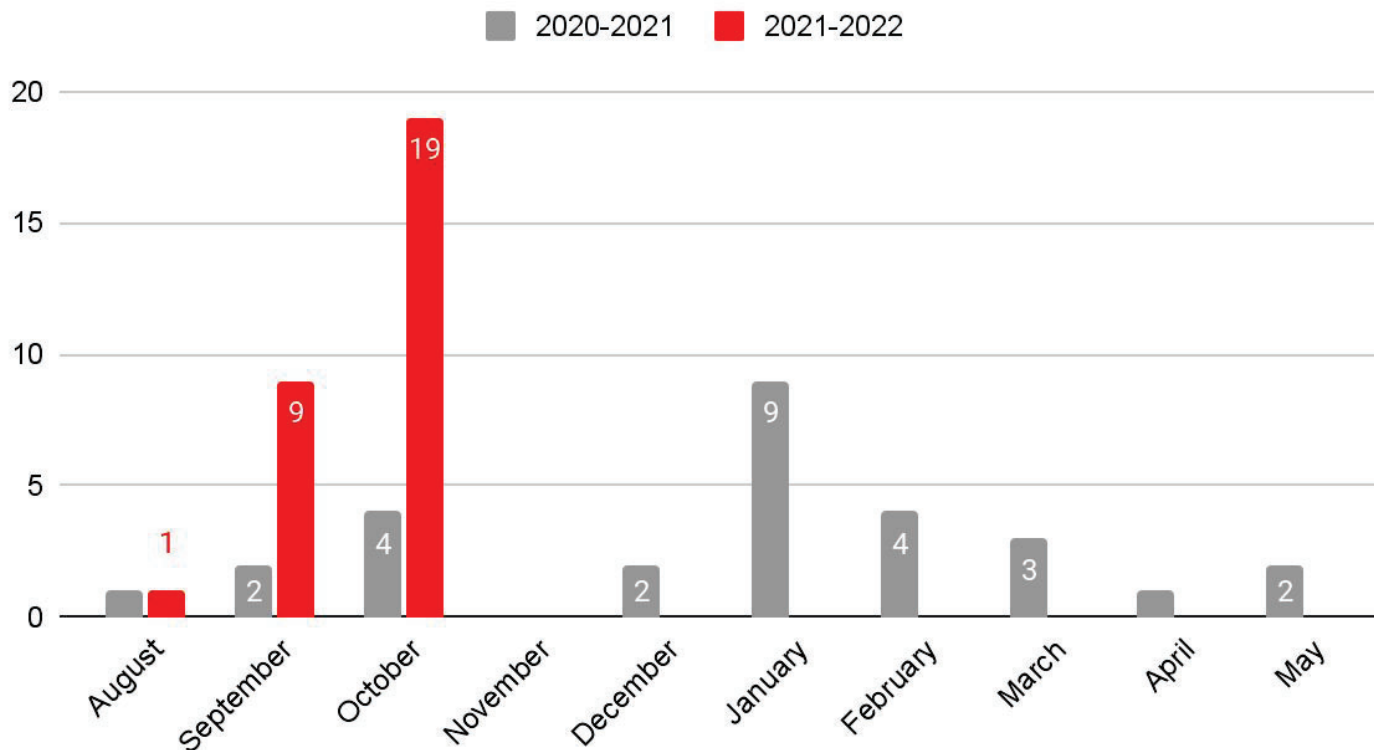
### ISS Reasons:

- Disrespect/non-compliance
- Inappropriate Physical Contact/Horseplay
- Skipping (advanced intervention)

- Fighting/Physical Aggression
- Vaping/Possession of Vape Device
- Extreme disruption of the learning environment
- Extreme disrespect/non-compliance

## Other Information for OHS

- Vape detectors are now active at OHS as of October. The process for investigating includes coordinating times of the alert with hallway cameras. Students are then interviewed and searched. If students are repeatedly in the bathroom for periods of time when the detector is set off, they will also face consequences for presumed guilt of use, even if they are not found in possession. This is after student warnings and parent contacts to notify them of concern. Those who are found in use or possession will be issued a ticket from the Oregon Police Department in addition to an OHS consequence. This is one reason behind the increase in suspensions for October.
