# **Athletic Community Service**

Football – Football team members performed several services this season. In July, the program again volunteered to work at Etnyre Manufacturing's Family Fair. They also helped at the football programs' Iron Hawks Golf Event Fundraiser and the youth camp in the summer. They also helped move new equipment into and setup the OHS Weight Room in the Blackhawk Center. These efforts totaled almost 600 service hours.

#### **Fall Sports**

Football – The varsity football team finished the season with a 2-7 record. The sophomore squad finished also finished 2-7.

*Volleyball* – The varsity volleyball finished with an overall record of 22-13-1, and 8-2 in BNC games, good enough for 3<sup>rd</sup> place behind Rock Falls and Rfd. Lutheran. The JV squad was 13-12-1 overall, 5-5 in BNC games.

Soccer – The Hawks won the IHSA Class 1A Regional and finished with an overall record of 16-9, 5-3 in Big Northern games, tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> place behind Mendota and Dixon.

*Cross Country* – The girls team finished in 5<sup>th</sup> place of 10 schools at the Big Northern Conference meet while the boys finished 8<sup>th</sup> of 10. The girls team qualified for the IHSA sectional meet by finishing in 6<sup>th</sup> place at the Winnebago 1A Regional. At the Sectional meet hosted here in Oregon at Park West, OHS had no state qualifiers. The girls team finished 12<sup>th</sup> of 18 teams.

Jr. High Boys Basketball – The DLR Jr. High season started in October.
