February 2019 Monthly Report

Oregon Elementary School

- Mr. Montanola met with 43 students individually several times. He ran 18 philosophical discussion groups, 16 social skills groups, six peer conflict resolution groups with a total of 103 students and 163 individualized student work in class interventions. In addition to, he taught 10 socioemotional lessons.
- Mrs. Stewart had 52 individual sessions with students on the topics of behavior, academic concerns, and social/emotional concerns. Mrs. Stewart also conducted 27 classroom lessons in pre-k thru 3rd grade, most of the classroom topics in February centered around kindness which tied in with the Great Kindness Challenge that was led by the Student Ambassadors at OES. Mrs. Stewart also facilitated 5 social groups and 4 Student Ambassadors meetings. OES participated in the Great Kindness Challenge, we had dress-up days and challenged each student to complete as many acts of kindness as they could in the building during that week. Each student was given a checklist of suggested acts of kindness to complete.

David L. Rahn Junior High School

- Mrs. Cermak continues to meet with students individually and in small groups.
- Meetings this month included grade level meetings, Student Assistance Team meetings, student services department, IEP meetings, meetings with parents, and special ed department meeting..
- Attended Juvenile Justice Council Meeting with presentation on threat assessments

- High school course selection meeting & appointments were held for all 8th grade students for individual course selection
- Began work on master schedule planning for 2019-20 school year.
- Illinois Assessment of Readiness: planned testing schedule and student accommodations, created testing sessions in PowerSchool.

Oregon High School

- Counselors hosted a presentation to all 8th grade students and parents about high school courses and the class registration process on February 4th.
- Counselors completed meetings with all current 9th-11th grade students regarding schedule requests for 2019-2020. Counselors also spent a week at DLR meeting hosting individual student meetings about high school classes and four-year plans. Parents were also welcome to attend these meetings.
- Ms. Cremeens took around 30 students to the Whiteside Area Career Center for a tour and to learn about their programs on February 5th.
- Mr. Turffs and Ms. Cremeens attended a PaCE training help at Stillman Valley High School. An implementation team will host their first meeting on March 4th. <https://www.isac.org/pace/documents/pace-framework.pdf>
- A Practice SAT was proctored by Mr. Turffs and Ms. Cremeens on February 14th. All juniors participated in this final practice test before the state SAT date in April.
