Oregon Elementary School

- Mrs. Stewart had 60 individual student meetings. She also facilitated 45 classroom lessons in Pre-K through 3rd grade, this month lessons all focused on different emotions as well as emotional regulation.
- Mrs. Stewart held 5 Student Ambassador meetings where students worked on the Veteran's Day assembly as well as planning for the next several months. Mrs. Stewart also began lunch groups with K-1 students, groups are focused on social skills, emotional regulation, and self-esteem.
- Mrs. Stewart also chaperoned field trips with Kindergarten and 1st grade to assist with several students. She also attended parent-teacher conferences of students that she works with on a consistent basis.
- Mrs. Stewart also attended a Vaping training with Mrs. Cermak as well as monthly SAT meetings, REMS training, monthly staff meeting, IEP meetings, and several student teaming meetings.
- Mr. Montanola met with 48 students individually several times. He ran 36 philosophical discussion groups, 28 SEL/social skills groups, two peer conflict group with a total of 96 students and 56 individualized student work in class interventions. Furthermore, he did two home visits.
