Winter Sports Update

<u>OHS Boys Basketball</u> – The varsity boys finished their season with a 14-18 record, 3-7 in Big Northern Conference play. The Hawks defeated North Boone in the opening round of the IHSA Class 2A regional, before falling to Byron in the regional semifinal game.

<u>OHS Wrestling</u> – Four Hawks took home medals at the IHSA State Finals at the University of Illinois - Jacob Milliman (3rd), Chase Clark (3rd), Noah Paul (3rd) and Andrew Herbst (4th).

<u>JH Wrestling</u> – The JH wrestlers completed their season at the Rt. 72 Tournament here in Oregon on Tuesday, March 5 with a 1st place finish out of six teams. Five DLR wrestlers earned first place individually.

<u>JH Girls Basketball</u> – Both the 7th and 8th grade teams ended their seasons at the Rt. 72 Conference girls basketball tournament at Pecatonica on March 2. The 8th grade team finished conference play with a 4-2 record while the 7th grade went 2-4 in conference games.
