February 2020 Monthly Report

Oregon Elementary School

- Mr. Montanola met with 41 students individually several times. He ran 44 philosophical discussion groups, 30 SEL/social skills groups, nine peer conflict groups and 170 individualized student work in class interventions with a total of 106 students.
- Mrs. Stewart met with 35 students individually. She also facilitated 8 lunch groups which focused on being proactive as well as emotions. Mrs. Stewart also led 3 Student Ambassador groups, they are working with Ms. Callaway to organize an book drive for OES. Mrs. Stewart also conducted 40 classroom lessons in pre-k through 3rd grade, topics included building friendships and career exploration. Mrs. Stewart, along with Mrs. Costa, presented at the OES staff meeting on the topic of building relationships and understanding what our students carry in terms of stressors in their lives. Mrs. Stewart had several parent meetings she participated in this month, IEP meetings, SAT meetings, and the Student Services meeting.

David L. Rahn Junior High School

- Mrs. Cermak continues to meet with students individually and in small groups at DLR.
- 8th grade students attended the course selection information meeting at OHS and individual meetings at DLR.
- Meetings this month included IEP meetings at OES and DLR, Student Assistance Team meetings, grade level meetings, truancy meetings with parents and students, PLC meeting, The Leader in Me team meeting, parent meetings, and a department meeting.

Oregon High School

- Counselors hosted a 9th Grade Course Information Night for 8th grade students and families on February 10th.
- Counselors hosted individual 8th grade meetings at DLR the month of February. Students selected high school classes and created a four year plan.
- Counselors proctored a Practice SAT for all juniors on February 19th.
- Counselors finished course requests for students grades 9-11 during the month of February.

District Student Services
