Current Enrollment:

7th Grade – 127 8th Grade – 109

SIP Goals & Progress:

Goal: IAR scores will increase by 15% in ELA and Math compared to 2019 scores. Another 8% in 2021 and 7% in 2022

- 1) Winter MAP testing scores have been reviewed by staff and meeting held to adjust Response to Intervention sections accordingly.
- 2) Math and reading charts illustrate growth from fall to winter.

Goal: Teachers will observe a colleague no less than once per quarter using Rigor Rubric with a follow up discussion regarding rigor/instructional strategies used.

1) 9/14 core teachers completed 2nd qtr. rigor visits to their peer's classrooms. 3rd qtr. visits will take place with Diane Jones, ICLE coach.

Goal: 85% of students will exhibit a positive feeling towards school

- 1) 27/236 students still maintain perfect attendance status
- 2) Overall attendance rate is 94.4%

Professional Development:

1/08 & 2/05 – On both days Steve Herkert, my professional coach, met with the staff to discuss the outcomes of last year's 5 Essentials survey in preparation for taking this years. Lighthouse coordinators and principals are scheduled to meet again with Meridian district leaders on Monday, March 16th to further collaborate ideas.


7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens book studies continue during homeroom at both the 7th and 8th grade levels.
