School Improvement Goal 1 Academics (SAT score improvement)

Started voluntary SAT prep Tues/Friday

- Students signed up for Math, English and/or Science
- During study hall
- Teachers doing test taking skills and practice items with students
- Students also utilizing test prep through Khan Academy
- Incentive for students who attend 75% of the sessions and improve their score from fall to spring
- Approximately 50 students in the program

School Improvement Goal 2 Culture & Climate

Increased Rigor:

Expanded Honors opportunities for 2020-2021 school year

- Any student can earn honors credit for science, math or social studies courses
- All sections of these courses will be differentiated to include "stretch" activities that meet honors criteria
- Activities will include (but are not limited to) assessment questions that are of a higher Depth of Knowledge level; projects that integrate synthesis and application of skills; larger range of skills and/or deeper experiences



School improvement goal 3 Professional Practice & Growth

Professional Learning:

Teachers participating in peer to peer observations

- Teachers indicated classrooms that they want to visit
- Schedule arranged so teachers have an opportunity to visit 2 classrooms
- Observation notes left for their peers
- Reflection notes for the visiting teacher
- Debrief will take place with ICLE consultant when she visits on Feb 24
