

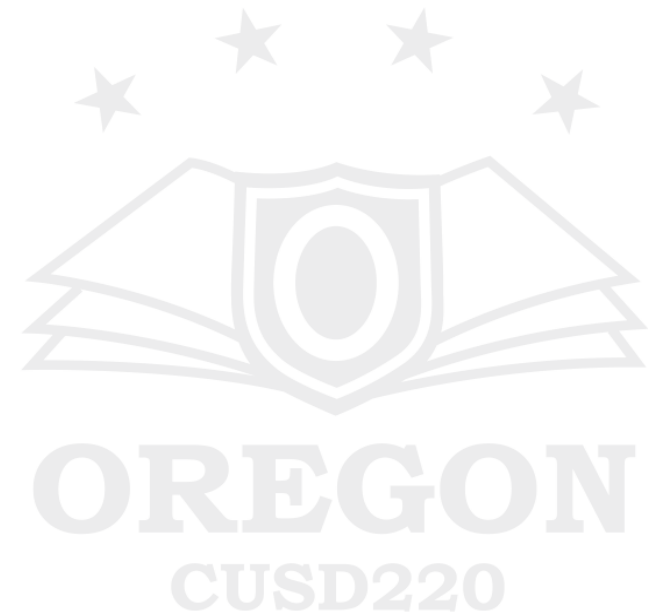

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School Improvement Goals

Goal 1: OHS students will improve the percentage of meets/exceeds by 3-5% from Spring 2019-Spring 2020 on the PSAT 9/10 and SAT.

Action Steps:

- Math & ELA department SMART goals for SAT prep, including bi-weekly data update
- Academic interventions for struggling students in the form of group tutoring (labs), individual tutoring and peer tutoring



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School Improvement Goals

Goal 2: Increase school connectedness score on 5 Essentials from 37 to 40 (students) and from 34 to 40 for Collective Responsibility (staff)

Action Steps:

- SIP day (October 11) designed to increase teacher collaboration
- 229 (55%) students involved in fall sports and/or band



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School Improvement Goals

Goal 3: OHS will develop into highly effective professional learning communities, as measured by the Critical Issues for Team Consideration rating scale

Action Steps:

- Team leader training district-wide using the Critical Friends Protocol
