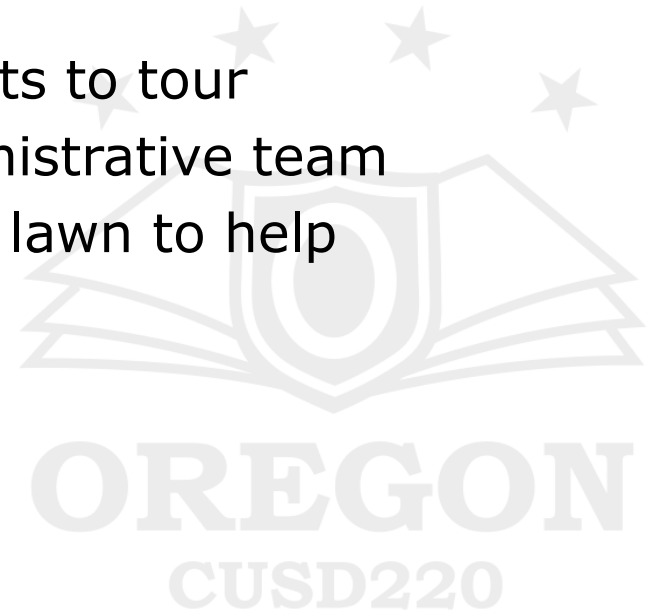




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Back to School Freshmen Orientation

- Activities and Athletics fair on the front lawn to help students get involved

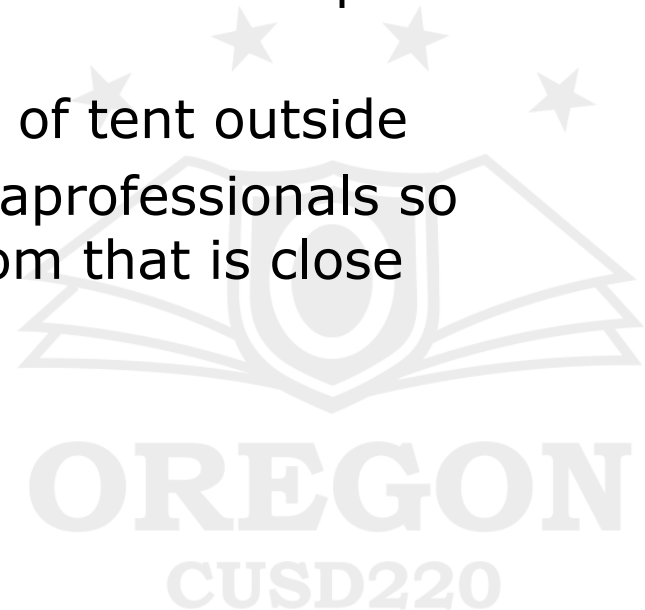




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Preparations for Return to School
