### **Fall Sports Update**

Volleyball – As of October 15, the varsity volleyball team has a record of 12-8 and is 4-2 in BNC games and in third place currently. They have earned the #7 seed of the 12 teams in the subsectional and will playing in the Stillman Valley 2A Regional on Monday, October 28 vas Byron. The JV team is 8-9-1 overall while the fresh/soph are 9-9 overall.

Boys Golf – The varsity boys finished 7-8 in dual meets and 3-7 in BNC matches. They finished in 8<sup>th</sup> place of 11 teams at the BNC Tournament at Timber Pointe on October 3. At the IHSA Class 1A Regional at Silver Ridge, the team finished 7<sup>th</sup> of 12.

Girls Golf – The girls finished with a 7-5 dual meet record, 4-4 in conference matches. At the Big Northern Tournament on Octobr 2, the girls finished in 6<sup>th</sup> place of nine teams. At the IHSA 1A regional at Lena-Winslow, on Oct. 3, the team finished in third out of nine teams and qualified for sectional. Freshman Ava Hackman was the overall #1 finisher at regional.

Soccer – The Hawks finished the regular season with a 14-8 overall record, 5-3 in Big Northern games which tied for third place in the standings. The Hawks won their Regional opener at Johnsburg winning 5-0 on October 15. They played for the regional title on Sat. Oct 19.

Football – Through Week 7, the varsity football and sophomore football teams both had 1-6 records.

Cross Country – The girls finished 1<sup>st</sup> of 4 at our last home meet on October 2, 6<sup>th</sup> of 7 at the Freeport Inv. on October 5, and 11<sup>th</sup> of 25 at the Amboy Columbus Day meet. The boys finished 3<sup>rd</sup> of 7 at our last home meet, 13<sup>th</sup> of 15 at the Freeport Inv., and 23<sup>rd</sup> of 26 at Amboy.

JH Volleyball – The DLR 8<sup>th</sup> grade volleyball team finished in 1<sup>st</sup> place at the Rt. 72 Conference Tournament at the Blackhawk Center on September 29. The 7<sup>th</sup> graders finished in 5<sup>th</sup> place at the event.
