## **Spring Sports Update**

Baseball – Heading into the regional opener, the varsity baseball team is currently 3-22-1, and 0-19-1 in BNC play..

Softball – The varsity softball team finished their season on May 14 dropping their regional opener to Winnebago 9-5. The team finished with a 4-22 overall record, 3-15 in BNC play.

Girls Soccer – The girls soccer team finished their second season with a record of 5-15-2, 1-8 in conference play. They defeated Marengo 3-0 in the Oregon Regional opener for the first post-season win in program history.

Boys Track – The OHS boys finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the Big Northern Conference in Genoa-Kingston on May 10. They participated in the Oregon Sectional on May 18.

Girls Track – The OHS girls finished in fourth place at the at the Big Northern Conference Meet on May 3 and in 3<sup>rd</sup> place of 15 at the Sectional in Lena-Winslow. The 4x100 relay team along with Abigail Hopkins (hurdles), Cynthia Nyderek (hurdles) and Lydia Cermak (200m) all qualified for the state meet.

Junior High Track – The DLR JH teams competed at the Rt. 72 Conference meet at OHS on May 8. The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys both were conference champs while the 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls took second. DLR hosted the IESA sectional here in Oregon on May 12. Both the 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys and the 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls finished in second place of the 14 teams. There were multiple individuals and several relay teams that qualified for the Jr. State Meet in East Peoria May 18 & 19..
