Highlights for the month:

- **Mr. Turffs and Ms. Cremeens assisted with grief counseling at Stillman Valley High School on two occasions this month for a student death.**
- **Mr. Turffs attended a tour of the new Woodward facility in Loves Park to learn about their manufacturing programs.**
- **Ms. Cremeens, Mrs. Kitzmiller, and Mr. Cozzi meet with students interested in taking the Hawk Helpers class next school year. This class requires an application, and students will have an opportunity to work with the OCEC classroom at OHS.**
- **On February 12th, the District Student Services Team held their monthly meeting.**
- **Ms. Cremeens attended meetings to create a “Return to Learn” plan for students who suffer from a head injury/concussion and need to be transitioned appropriately back into school.**
- **On February 23rd, all district student services personnel and OCEC met to discuss RTI in the buildings and will be working to create a document that charts interventions available.**
- **On February 24th, all sophomores attended college visits to either the University of Dubuque or the University of Wisconsin – Platteville.**
- **The Illinois Youth Survey was administered in 10th and 12th grade English classes on February 25th. This survey will provide data regarding student substance use, bullying, adult relationships, and student health. School and county data will be available at an unknown future date.**
